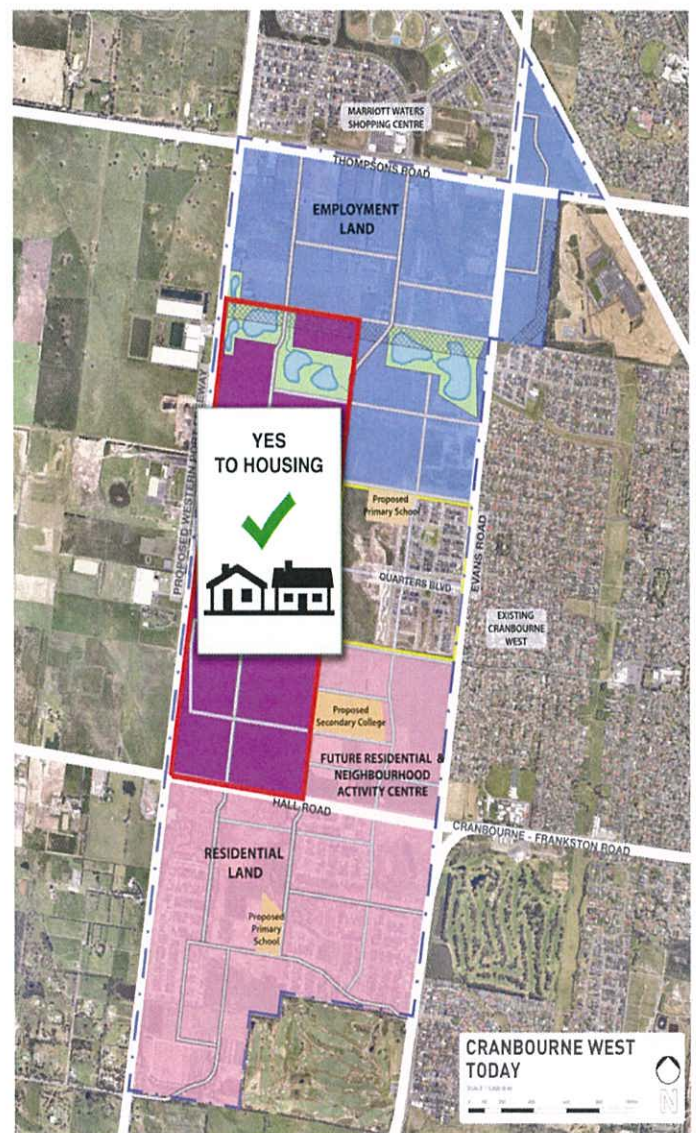

Why are Cranbourne West Residents against Industrial?

- 1 **It will significantly devalue our homes**
- 2 **It will bring noise and pollution to our quiet green community**
- 3 **It will create an unsafe environment for our families with heavy trucks and vehicles**
- 4 **45m high large warehouses would be built across the land which would create an ugly looking neighbourhood and outlook**
- 5 **Trucks and Heavy Vehicles will clog up our roads**

You only have to look to other neighbourhoods (eg Moorabbin, Seaford, Richmond, Kensington) where Industrial has been placed close to housing to see the impacts it has on housing values and quality of life.



Other News

Residents who have emailed the Minister for Planning have received a standard letter back from his Planning Department DELWP.

This letter says that the Minister for Planning is waiting for the City of Casey to request an amendment to the Cranbourne West Precinct Structure Plan (PSP) before the Minister will meet with residents about the matter. The letter also says that if there is a request from Council to amend the PSP, then he will allow the community to make their views known through the process.

The City of Casey will make this request once they have met with the Minister for Planning in person to talk to him about the issue of planning an industrial park on the doorstep of the Cranbourne West community. This meeting will occur in the coming weeks.

Council and Government Officers continue to obstruct the Democratic Process

It is understood that despite the City of Casey supporting its people and voting against an industrial park on the land, that Council workers and State Government workers continue to obstruct the democratic process and advise the Minister that the land should remain as an industrial park.

None of these officers live in your community. They haven't been voted into power by the community. If the Minister for Planning was to decide that the land should remain for an industrial park, then he would be ignoring the Community's voice and allowing Council and State Government workers to run Government.
