On 30 September 2015, the City of Casey listened to our community and asked the Minister for Planning to change the Casey Planning Scheme to allow residential and not industrial in Cranbourne West.

Our Community has already let Government know they want the change to happen. More action is now required because the Minister for Planning's bureaucrats are still telling him Industrial should go ahead.
