**CRANBOURNE WEST
ROAD NETWORK CAMPAIGN**

We have commenced a campaign to bring the State Government, The City of Casey and other important stakeholders to the table with a Demand for Action.

The Cranbourne West Road network is congested and highly dangerous particularly Hall Road between Westernport Highway and the Frankston/Cranbourne road including the unsignalised intersection at Evans Road.

The Cranbourne West road network has been neglected for far too long. We have had enough!!

ACTION SO FAR

- We have sent a letter to Luke Donnellan, State Minister for Roads and local member of Narre Warren to request an urgent appointment.
- We have a meeting arranged next week for an appointment with our local member, Jude Perera and new candidate Pauline Richards.

ROAD WORK PRIORITIES

Our primary focus initially will be on completion of the widening of Hall Road from Western Port Highway to Cranbourne Frankston Road, and the Hall Road/Evans Road signalised intersection

The second phase will be to obtain from the State Government a commitment and timetable to upgrade the Westernport highway intersection with Hall Road and a widening of Hall Road to Carrum Downs
